Clinical hours can be obtained in the role of a student in an accredited nuclear medicine program prior to becoming a certified technologist. If the applicant has/will not complete all 500 hours prior to graduation – please complete the form and give to directly to the graduating student. The student can submit the form with their application for the CT exam when and if they complete the total 500 hours required.
