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### **PET Didactic Coursework Report Sheet**

PET Specialty Examination applicants who do not hold a nuclear medicine technology credential, but do hold an active CAMRT(RT), CAMRT(RTT), ARRT(R) or ARRT(T) certification, must document the satisfactory completion of a minimum of seventy (70) contact hours of coursework in the following areas: 20 hours in PET Procedures; 20 hours in Nuclear Medicine Instrumentation; 10 hours in Radiation Protection; 20 hours in Radiopharmacy.

Only coursework from an accredited college or university, an accredited nuclear medicine program, or approved continuing education credits recognized by NMTCB, such as VOICE/ECE, will be accepted. These didactic coursework requirements must be completed within the 5-year period immediately prior to application to sit for the PET specialty examination.

This report sheet must be completed for proper submission of the 70 hours of coursework. <u>Please enclose verification of your completion of each course listed.</u> Copying of this document is allowed.
